FIRST COURSE

Endless River

A German-style Kolsch with soul and flavor, Endless River is our answer to light beer. Light and crisp, with a delicate body and ever-so-slight floral tang in the finish, Endless River provides endless waves of flavor, and unquestionably, endless enjoyment

SECOND COURSE

Weeping Willow Wit

Weeping Willow Wit, our Belgian-style Wit Beer, has been a crowd favorite since our brewery began in 2009. Light in body and brewed with the classic Belgian spice cocktail of orange peel and coriander, this wheat beer is sunny and refreshing, with complexity and depth provided by the spices.
